# OAB HALL OF FAME NOMINATION

Hall of Fame nominees are scored and selected based on the information submitted under the five categories listed below. The completeness and clarity of the information submitted is an important factor in the judging. Explicit information must be submitted in all of the categories.

The nomination packet should contain a cover page listing the nominee, their home address, e-mail address, and telephone number. The same information should be provided for the person preparing the nomination.

Please provide a separate page for each category.

The judging categories are:

**1. Contributions to the Profession**

During their career, what contributions did they make that benefited the Broadcasting profession through their work in local community, state, regional, or national industry organizations or projects?

**2. Broadcast Career**

A brief resume of the nominee's career with highlights emphasized.

**3. Recognition and Awards**

List major broadcast industry awards or recognition received.

**4. Local, State, or National Activities**

Exemplary participation in local, state or national organizations and any recognition received.

**5. Reasons Nominee Should be Selected**

Your own personal views as to why this nominee should be in the OAB Hall of Fame.

Additional information or letters (up to five) may be included in the nomination packet.
